#### OPINION

In this proceeding The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, requests permission to establish a telephone exchange at Buena Park, Orange County, California, with rates for telephone and telegraph service.

A public hearing in this application was held by Examiner Rowell on April 16, 1929, at Buena Park, when the matter was submitted for decision.

Applicant contends that Buena Park is a self-contained community with a population of some 3,500 people with more than 100 store locations and 700 residences; that schools, churches, a bank, library, railroad depots, a Chamber of Commerce and other organizations which pertain to a separate community, are established in Buena Park. It is proposed to include in the new exchange area a section of the Fullerton Exchange Area and a

small portion of the Anaheim Exchange Area. Applicant submitted a map of the territory proposed to be served from a step-by-step dial central office. The same kinds of services now available in the Fullerton Exchange will be offered in the proposed exchange.

The Buena Park Chamber of Commerce supported the application by several witnesses and its president testified that he had made some effort for four years past to secure the establishment of such a separate exchange and recently had circulated petitions to ascertain the desires of the people of the community as to the separate telephone exchange.

Applicant's witness presented in evidence, at the hearing, a map of the territory which it was proposed to include in the Buena Park Exchange Area. One resident of Fuller Park objected to the inclusion of a section of that tract in the Buena Park Exchange Area, as requested by applicant. There appears no sufficient reason why the exchange area boundary should not be so located as to allow this resident of Fuller Park and those represented by her to have service directly and regularly from the Fullerton Central Office.

The exchange rates proposed by applicant for service in the Buena Park Exchange are on a comparable level with rates for similar service under similar conditions at other places in California. Some changes in interexchange rates will affect telephone charges to users in this section and a five-cent toll charge is requested for messages between Buena Park and either Fullerton or Anaheim. These rates are constructed on the plan in general use in the State of California and will be approved. No change in telegraph service is involved in the Company's proposal.

All the evidence received in this proceeding has been given proper consideration and it appears that the interests of this community require the establishment of a Buena Park Exchange to furnish service in an area as proposed by applicant and shown in Exhibit No. 1, filed at the hearing in this proceeding, excepting that the eastern boundary shall be located as follows:

"Beginning at the northeast corner of the exchange area as proposed and extending south parallel to and 1000 feet distant from Magnolia Avenue to a point 500 feet north of West Commonwealth Avenue; thence westward 500 feet from and parallel to West Commonwealth to a point 1700 feet west of North Magnolia Avenue; thence southward 1700 feet from and parallel to North Magnolia Avenue to a point 500 feet south of Valencia Avenue; thence eastward 500 feet from and parallel to Valencia Avenue to a point 1000 feet from North Magnolia Avenue, thence southward 1000 feet from and parallel to South Magnolia Avenue to its intersection with south boundary of the proposed Buena Park Exchange as shown in map in above mentioned Exhibit No. 1."

The request of applicant as to the extent of the primary rate area as appearing in Exhibit "B", attached to the application, was modified as shown in Exhibit No. 2, filed in evidence at the hearing. Applicant should establish the primary rate area as modified.

#### ORDER

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company having requested authority from the Railroad Commission to establish a telephone exchange at Buena Park, Orange County, California, and to make effective certain rates for exchange telephone service therein, and rates for interexchange telephone service and telegraph service between the proposed exchange and other points, a public hearing having been held in the proceeding, and the matter having been submitted for decision,

The Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby finds as a fact that the public interests require the

establishment of a telephone exchange at Buena Park by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and, basing its order on the foregoing finding of fact and such other findings of fact as are contained in the opinion which precedes this order,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company shall:

- (1) Establish and begin to operate within (6) months from and after the date of this order a dial system telephone exchange at Buena Park, Orange County, with continuous twenty-four (24) hour service in an exchange area with boundaries as shown on a map thereof appearing in Exhibit No. 1, filed at the hearing in this proceeding, except as to the eastern boundary which shall be located as described in words and figures in the opinion preceding this order.
- (2) Establish a primary rate area for Buena Park
  Exchange with boundaries as shown on a map filed as Exhibit No.
  2 at the hearing herein, effective on and after the date of
  the establishment of said exchange.
- (3) Establish rates for local exchange telephone service in the Buena Park Exchange, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and such other exchange telephone rates as may be approved effective on and after the date of the establishment of said exchange.
- vice and telegraph service between the Buena Park Exchange and outside points, as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and such other interexchange telephone and telegraph rates as may be approved, effective on and after the date of the establishment of said exchange.

- (5) Submit to the Railroad Commission of the State of California, for filing, maps showing the exchange and primary rate areas and rates for local exchange telephone service, interexchange telephone service and telegraph service for the Buena Park Exchange, as referred to in (1), (2), (3) and (4) above, on or before the fifth day immediately preceding the date of the establishment of the Buena Park Exchange.
- (6) Discontinue all local exchange telephone service from the Fullerton and Anaheim Exchanges in Buena Park Exchange Area as of the date of the establishment of said exchange.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
