ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at its non-agency station of Baldwin Park on the Covina Branch of its Los Angeles Division in Los Angeles County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (L.A.Div.Drwg.No.B-394) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that there is no passenger train service on said Covina Branch and said shelter shed is not now being used; that no passenger business was transacted at said Baldwin Park Station during the annual period ending January 31, 1929; that the maintenance of said shelter shed is not now necessary nor likely to become necessary in the future for the business of the applicant or the public since all railroad passenger traffic thereto and therefrom is handled by Pacific Electric Railway Company.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and

it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove a passenger shelter shed at its non-agency station of Baldwin Park, located on the Covina Branch of its Los Angeles Division in Los Angeles County as shown in yellow on blue print map (L.A.Div.Drwg.No.P-294) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
