O P I N I O N

This is an application of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, for an order approving a certain agreement, dated April 4, 1929, made and entered into by and between applicant and R. C. A. Communications, Inc., a corporation, located near Bolinas Point, Marin County, California, and engaged in transmitting and receiving messages by radio. A copy of this agreement, marked "Exhibit A," is attached to the application.

The agreement provides that applicant will furnish electric energy, under its filed Schedule P-1, to R. C. A. Communications, Inc. Applicant's estimated cost of providing facilities to render such service is Sixty-two thousand four hundred thirty-eight (62,438) Dollars. R. C. A. Communications, Inc., agrees to receive such service for a period of ten (10) years and to install for operation electric apparatus of certain minimum rated capacities. The Commission is of the opinion that the agreement is fair to both parties and that a public hearing in this proceeding is not necessary.

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having applied to this Commission for an order approving a certain agreement entered into by and between applicant and R. C. A. Communications, Inc., dated April 4, 1929, the Commission having considered the matter and being of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above mentioned agreement between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and R. C. A. Communications, Inc., be and the same is hereby approved.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
