In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment of non-agency station at Virginia, County of Santa Cruz, State of California, and the abandonment and removal of a side track at said Station.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station at Virginia on its College Park and Santa Cruz Branch in Santa Cruz County, and the abandonment and removal of a spur track 350 feet in length at said station as shown in yellow (color) on a blue-print map (Coast Division Drawing 23733) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at said non-agency station since November 1st, 1927; that said track is no longer used and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the

public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Virginia located on the College Park and Santa Cruz Branch of its Coast Division in Santa Cruz County; to abandon and remove a spur track 350 feet in length located at said station and shown in yellow on the map attached to the application; to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
