In the Matter of the application of the SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of an old passenger station building at Ocean View, County of San Francisco, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger station building located at its non-agency station of Ocean View on its San Francisco-San Bruno Branch in San Francisco, California, and shown in yellow (color) on a blue-print map ( Coast Division Drawing 23892 ) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that \$12.00 passenger business representing the revenue from 44 passengers was transacted at the non-agency station of Ocean View during the annual period ending December 31, 1928; that said passenger station has not been used since February, 1924, and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said passenger station is not

necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove its passenger station located at the non-agency station of Ocean View on its San Francisco-San Bruno Branch in San Francisco, California.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
