FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Napa Valley Bus Company did on June 23, 1927, apply to the Railroad Commission for permission to issue and sell \$50,000.00 of its common capital stock, and,

WHEREAS, the Commission by its Decision No. 18892 authorized the company to issue and sell, at not less than par, \$15,000.00 of such stock to pay for equipment and to provide working capital but held in abeyance the request to issue the remaining \$35,000.00 of stock for the reason that no showing was made at that time of the necessity for the issue thereof, and

WHEREAS, the Commission has been advised by the company that there is no necessity for the issue of further stock at this time and that the application insofar as it involves the issue of such remaining \$35,000.00 of stock might be dismissed without prejudice, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application, insofar as it involves the issue of the remaining \$35,000.00 of stock, be, and it hereby is, dismissed without prejudice.
