In the matter of the application of Pacific Electric Railway Company for authority to remove freight platform at Roosevelt Station, on its Gardena-San Pedro Line.

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight platform at Roosevelt Station, a non-agency station, on its Gardena-San Pedro Line in Los Angeles County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (C.E.H.11740) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that no less than carload shipments have been handled at the non-agency station of Roosevelt during the annual period ending March 31st, 1929; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove a freight platform at Roosevelt Station, a non-agency station, on its Gardena-San Pedro Line, in Los Angeles County as shown in yellow on blue print map (C.E.H.11740) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
