FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, this Commission in its Decision No.21080, after a public hearing, issued its order removing certain restrictions imposed on the operating right granted to the applicants herein covering service be tween Los Angeles and Victorville and territory contiguous to the last named point, and

WHEREAS it now appears that in order properly to clear the record covering said operating right a supplemental order removing said restriction should be issued in the matter of Application No.13691, now Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the restriction limiting applicants to the transportation of freight in quantities of not more than three tons from any one consignor to any one consignee, between Los Angeles and Victorville, and between Victorville and points ten miles north and thirty miles east and west thereof, all points to be north of a line drawn east and west through Hesperia be and the same is hereby removed.
