FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

This Commission by Decision No. 20670 dated the twelfth day of January, 1929, in the above entitled proceeding, having among other things made its Order preliminary to the issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity and having declared therein that it would thereafter issue a certificate of public convenience and necessity upon the filing by Palisades Del Rey Water Company of the proper evidence of a franchise, permit or consent from the proper public authorities to construct a water system and also upon the filing of a stipulation to the effect that applicant herein, its successors or assigns will never claim for said franchise, permit or consent a value in excess of the actual cost of securing same, which cost shall be set forth in said stipulation, and the said water company having filed with the Commission a certified copy of Ordinance No. 65383 of the City of Los Angeles permitting said company to lay and construct, maintain and operate a pipe line system for the purpose of transporting water in, under and along certain streets

in the City of Los Angeles, and also having filed in due form the stipulation as required in said Decision No. 20670, and it appearing that the certificate should now be granted and the rates as authorized and established in said decision be permitted to become effective as therein provided, now therefore

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Palisades Del Rey Water Company, a corporation, of a public utility water system in that portion of the City of Los Angeles more particularly described and set forth in Ordinance No. 63383 of the City of Los Angeles, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Palisades Del Rey Water Company be and it is hereby authorized to charge the schedule of rates established in Decision No. 20670 for all service rendered to its consumers on and after the date of the Order herein.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
