The People of the State of Celifornia, on relation of the Department of Public Morks, Division of Hiehmays, filed the above entitied application with this Comission on the 27th day of March, 2929, asking for authority to construct a State Eighway known as Road IV-Minn.-52-A overhead across the tracks of the Noc thwestern Pacific Railroad Compeny in the vicinity of the Station of ilto, County of Niarin and to close the present submay designated as Crossing No. 5C-10.9B as hereinatter set forth.

Saic Northwestern Pacific Reilroad Company has signified by letter thet it has no objection to the construction of said overhead crossing and the 30 erd of Supervisors of the County of Marin on May 20it, 1929, passec its resolution ajproving the ciosine of saić present subray designated as Crossing No. 5C-10.93.

It appears to the Comission that tilis is not a matter in which a public bearing is zecessary, and that this application should be granted, subject to the conditions heroinarter speciried, therefore

IT IS ERPEBY OPDEPED that permission and authority be and $1 t$ is hereby grented to the People of the Stave of Califoraie, on relation of the Depertment of Public Torks, Division of Hichways, to construct State Zighwey designated as Road IV - Mra.-52-A overhead across the tracks of the Nortiwestern Pacific Reilroad Company at the location as shown by the map (Exhibit A) attacher to. the applicetion.

The above crossing shali be icentified as Crossins No. 5C-10.7A.

Said crossing shall be constructed subject to the follow1ng concitions:
(1) Said overiead crossing sheil be constructec with clearances in eccorkance with the provisions of this Comission's General Orders No. 26-C and No. 64-A.
(2) The cost of construction and maintenance of said anead ene crossing shail be borne in accordance with an gereement or asreements to be hereinaiter entored into by the interested perties, fuliy executed copy or copies of said agreement or agreements shail be illea with this Comission. for its approval, Within sixty ( 60 ) deys from the date hereor. In the event an agreement cannot be reached by the interested parties, this commission $m 112$ apportion costs 0 an construction anc maintenance by subsequent order.
(3) ipplicant sinal2, before commencement of construction, file with this Comission a complete set of detailod plans of the proposed grade separation. Said deteiled plans to be epproved by the Northwestern Pecific Railroed Company.
(4) The existing undererade crossing located approximately six hundred (600) feet easteriy 0 : the grade seperetion herein authorized and designeted as Crossing No. 5C-20.9B shall be legaily abandonec gnd effectiveny closed to use and travel
upon the completion of the gracie separation authorized herein.
(5) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter notify this Commission in writing of the completion of the installation of said overgrade crossing and the closing of Crossing No. 5C-10.9B
(6) If said overgrade crossing shall not have been installed within one year from the date oi this order, the authorizeton herein granted shall then apse and become void unless fir r the time is granted by subsequent order.

For all other purposes the authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
