OPINION and ORDER on SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION

In a supplemental application in the above entitled proceeding Dan A. Garibaldi has requested authority to discontinue operation of the automotive passenger and express service he was authorized to perform between Jackson and Pardee Dam by Decision No. 20195, dated September 4, 1928.

According to applicant Garibaldi his service has been conducted at a loss since its inception. He states that during the months of March, April and May of this year he transported only seven passengers, his revenue therefrom totaling but \$17.50. He declares that the prospects for an increase in traffic are not bright, particularly in view of the near completion of the dam.

The certificate granted by Decision No. 20195 authorized service on Saturdays and Sundays with the provision that daily service would be established if need therefor developed. The expected development did not materialize, according to Garibaldi, hence the application.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Dan A. Garibaldi be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue operation of the automotive passenger

and express service between Jackson and Pardee Dam he was authorized to establish by Decision No.20195, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Dan A. Caribaldi by said Decision No.20195 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules filed with the Railroad Commission by Dan A. Caribaldi covering said service be and the same are hereby canceled.
