FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER


WHEREAS, A. F. Stephens, to whom this Commission by

convenience and necessity heretofore granted to A. F. Stephens

annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariffs and time
schedules filed by A. F. Stephens covering said service be and the
same are hereby canceled.
