BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the Application of the Railway Express Agency, Inc. for authority to abandon its agency at Spreckles, County of Monterey, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Railway Express Agency, Inc., has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency of Spreckles, in Monterey County.

Applicant alleges because of abandonment of operations by Pajaro Valley Consolidated Railroad Company, which has heretofore transported express in and out of Spreckles, it will be unable to longer conduct said agency. California Farm Bureau has advised the Commission that it has no objection to the granting of the application, and it appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Railway Express Agency, Inc., a corporation, to abandon its agency station of Spreckles, in Monterey County, and to eliminate said name from its station records, and to amend in conformity with the rules of this Commission

all rate tariffs applying at said station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
