IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that W. A. Bailey be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue operation of automotive stage service he was authorized to perform by Railroad Commission Decision No.5595, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER OPDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to W. A. Bailey by said Decision No.5595 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariffs and time schedules filed with the Railroad Commission by said W. A. Bailey be and the same are hereby canceled.
