ORDER

The City of Oakland, applicant herein, having on June 22nd, 1929, requested an extension of time of ninety (90) days in which to install the crossing authorized by Decision No. 19785, in the above entitled proceeding; it appearing that said crossing has not been installed within one year from the date of said decision, in accordance with Condition (5) thereof, and the Commission being of the opinion that public convenience and necessity warrant the construction of the crossing heretofore authorized by said decision,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to the City of Oakland to construct 85th Avenue at grade across the tracks owned by Central Pacific Railway Company and operated by Southern Pacific Company, at the location more particularly described by said Decision No. 19785, which decision, with the exception of condition (5) thereof, is incorporated herein and made a part hereof; provided, however, that if said crossing shall not have been installed prior to the 21st of August, 1929, the

authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void,
unless further time is granted by subsequent order prior to that
date.
