ORDER**ORIGINAL**

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Araz, on its Los Angeles Division in Imperial County, California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger or freight business was transacted at the non-agency station of Araz during the annual periods ending April 30, 1929 and March 31, 1929, respectively, and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation,

to abandon its non-agency station of Araz, located on its Los Angeles Division in Imperial County and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
