

Decision No. 21365.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, for an order authorizing the construction of a State highway subway under the tracks of the Western Pacific Railroad 1 3/4 miles east of Doyle, Lassen County.

ORDER

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on the 26th day of June, 1929, asking for authority to construct a State Highway known as Road II-Las-29-E below grade under the track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company 1-3/4 miles east of Doyle, Lassen County.

Said Western Pacific Railroad Company has signified by letter that it has no objection to the construction of said under-grade crossing. It appears to this Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that this application should be granted, subject to the conditions hereinafter specified, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, to construct State Highway designated as Road II-Las-29-E at separated grades under the track of The Western Pacific Railroad

Company at the location as shown by the map attached to the application.

The above crossing shall be identified as Crossing No. 4-361.4B.

Said undergrade crossing shall be constructed subject to the following conditions:

(1) Said undergrade crossing shall be constructed with clearances in accordance with the provisions of this Commission's General Orders No. 26-C and No. 64-A.

(2) The cost of construction and maintenance of said undergrade crossing will be apportioned by this Commission by subsequent order. Applicant shall file within sixty (60) days from the date of this order copy or copies of any agreement or agreements between the interested parties, fully executed, relating to the cost of construction and maintenance of said undergrade crossing, for this Commission's approval.

(3) Applicant shall, before commencement of construction, file with this Commission a complete set of detailed plans of the grade separation herein authorized. Said detailed plans to be approved by The Western Pacific Railroad Company.

(4) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission in writing of the completion of the installation of said undergrade crossing.

(5) If said undergrade crossing shall not have been installed within one year from the date of this order, the authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

For all other purposes the authority herein granted

shall become effective on the date hereof.
