

The order requested by the supplemental application should, therefore, be granted and we are of the opinion that it is a matter which does not require a public hearing. Southern Pacific Company and Nevada County Narrow Gauge Railroad have advised the Commission that they have no objection to the issuance of the corrective order. Therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that that part of the order in Decision No. 16745 restricting service between Grass Valley and Sacramento be amended to read as follows:

*****Sierra Nevada Stages be and it is hereby granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate automobile stages for the transportation of passengers and express between Sacramento and Nevada City, serving intermediate points, except locally between Grass Valley and Nevada City, and points between Sacramento and Roseville *****

In all other respects the original order is to remain unchanged, no authority being granted by the order herein for the elimination of any restriction other than that between Sacramento and Grass Valley.
