O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight station building at its non-agency station of Igerna on its Shasta Division in Siskiyou County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (Shasta Division Drawing A.C.M. 4667) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the Richfield Oil Company, the principal shipper and consignee at said Igerna Station, has its own private spur track and receives its carload and less-than-carload freight on said spur, making no use of said freight station building and that said freight station building is not now needed nor likely to be needed in the future.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corpor-

ation, to abandon and remove its freight station building at its non-agency station of Igerna, located on the main line of its Shasta Division in Siskiyou County and as shown in yellow on a blue-print map (Shasta Division Drawing A.G.M. 4667) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
