FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

California Water Service Company in a supplemental petition filed in the above entitled matter on August 14, 1929, asks authority to execute and deliver a supplemental indenture in, or substantially in, the form of the indenture annexed to said supplemental petition and marked Exhibit "1". The purpose of executing the supplemental indenture is to make certain that the properties described in the supplemental indenture will be subject to the lien of the mortgage and/or deed of trust securing the payment of applicant's bonds.

We have considered the request of the company and believe that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the California Water Service Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to execute and deliver a supplemental indenture in, or substantially in, the form of the indenture filed in this proceeding and attached to the aforesaid supplemental petition as Exhibit "1", provided that the authority herein granted to execute and deliver such indenture is for the purpose of this proceeding only, and is granted only insofar as this Commission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act and is not intended as an approval of said indenture as to such other legal requirements to which said indenture may be subject.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty days after the execution and delivery of said indenture, California Water Service Company shall file with the Railroad Commission two certified copies thereof.
