ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY CERTIFICATE

Premier Mills, Inc. having filed an application seeking authorization to operate a public bulk storage elevator for grain, for compensation, in its bulk storage buildings at 936 to 956 McCarry Street, Los Angeles, California, it appearing that an emergency warrants the granting of a temporary permit or certificate, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Premier Mills Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to operate an elevator for the storage of grain, in bulk only, at the above address, during the pendency of this application and until final determination thereof, unless otherwise ordered by this Commission, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a finding that public convenience and necessity warrant the granting of the application, in whole or in part, it being intended by this order to

provide for the temporary emergency period solely.

The authorization herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
