SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Isabelle V. Borden, Administratrix of the estate of James Borden, in a sworn statement filed with the Commission under date of August 9, 1929, has advised that following the death of her husband she discontinued the operation of the automotive passenger stage service conducted by him under authority of a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by this Commission between Riverside and the University of California Experimental Station near that city.

Now, therefore,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to James Borden by Railroad Commission Decision No.10789 on Application No.8092 be, and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by said James Borden covering the service as granted be, and the same are hereby canceled.
