FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Frank Glassburner, to whom this Commission by its Decision No. 17892, dated January 12, 1927, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property between Red Bluff and Lyonsville, in an affidavit filed with this Commission under date of August 27, 1929, has declared that during the year last past he did not transport any passengers or freight and

WHEREAS, said Frank Glassburner has requested that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to him by Decision No. 17892 be revoked and annulled, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said certificate of public convenience and necessity be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff of rates and time schedules on file with the Railroad Commission in the name of Frank Glassburner be and the same are hereby canceled.
