FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good Cause Appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 21461,  
dated August 16, 1929, reading as follows:-

" IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Peerless Stages, Incorporated,  
be, and it hereby is, authorized to execute a deed of trust  
substantially in the same form as that filed in this proceeding  
and to issue a note, secured thereby, in the principal amount  
of \$25,000.00, payable in monthly installments of \$100.00 or  
more, with interest at the rate of six percent per annum, for  
the purpose of paying the \$25,000.00 note now outstanding,"

be, and it hereby is, modified so as to read--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Peerless Stages, Incorporated, be,  
and it hereby is, authorized to execute a deed of trust substantially  
in the same form as that filed in this proceeding and to issue a note  
secured thereby in the principal amount of \$25,000.00, payable on or  
before one year after date of issue with interest at the rate of six  
percent per annum, for the purpose of paying the \$25,000.00 note now  
outstanding.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 21461 dated August 16, 1929 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
