Decision No. 21592

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of Southern Pacific Company for authority to cancel all rates in freight tariffs to and from the non-agency station of Biola Junction in the County of Fresno, State of California, and to discontinue the handling of freight thereat.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the cancellation of all rates in freight tariffs to and from its non-agency station of Biola Junction on its Stockton Division in Fresno County and to discontinue the handling of freight at said station.

Applicant alleges that no freight business was transacted at said non-agency station during the annual period ending March, 1929, and that it is no longer necessary or desirable to continue to publish said Biola Junction as a station where freight will be received or delivered.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has advised the Commission that it will offer no objection to the granting of this application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation,

to cancel all rates in freight tariffs to and from its non-agency station of Biola Junction, located on its Stockton Division in Fresno County, and to discontinue the handling of freight at said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
