OPINION AND ORDER  
ON PETITION FOR MODIFICATION OF PRIOR ORDER

The City of South Pasadena has petitioned for a modification of our Decision No. 20911, in the above entitled proceeding, which decision granted permission to construct the North roadway of Huntington Drive at grade across the tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company. The petitioner requests that said decision be modified by eliminating therefrom Condition (4), which required the effective closing of the existing public crossing at Spruce Street as a condition precedent to the construction of the north roadway of Huntington Drive.
