O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency at Brookdale on its Boulder Creek Branch in Santa Cruz County.

It appears that applicant now maintains an agent at said station from June 15th to August 31st of each year in compliance with the Commission's Decision No. 15381, in Application No. 14631, and that approximately \$240.00 passenger business and approximately \$130.00 L. C. L. freight business was transacted at said station during the two and one-half month period in 1928 that an agent was maintained; that the abandonment of said agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the agency is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter

in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its agency at Brookdale, located on the Boulder Creek Branch in Santa Cruz County, on five (5) days' notice to the public and to this Commission, and to eliminate said station from its records as an agency station; provided, however, that coincident with the abandonment of said agency applicant will continue to maintain said station of Brookdale as a non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
