

Under the circumstances we are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Motor Transport Company be and it is hereby authorized to give, in addition to the service it is now performing to the depots of Southern Pacific rail company in the communities of Vallejo, Napa, Suisun and Cordelia, service to the depots or stations of California Transit Co., in said communities; provided, that the authority herein granted shall not be considered as a separate or additional operating right, nor as an enlargement of the right granted by Decision No.21194.
