

Decision No. 21689

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California, granting to applicant a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct the gas transmission lines and system therein described.

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In Decision No. 21311, dated July 1, 1929, this Commission made its order granting Pacific Gas and Electric Company a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the construction, maintenance and use of a certain natural gas transmission project and the exercise of all permits, easements and franchises used or useful in connection therewith. Such certificate was made contingent upon the following, among other conditions:

- (d) Lines shall not be constructed or operated in the County of Santa Clara unless and until Pacific Gas and Electric Company of California shall file with this Commission certified copies of all necessary franchises to lay and operate its natural gas transmission lines in said county.
- (e) Pacific Gas and Electric Company of California shall file with this Commission a stipulation duly executed on authority of its Board of Directors agreeing that it will never claim for any of the permits, easements and franchises used in connection with this project, a value in excess of the cost thereof.

- (f) Upon the filing of the franchises and stipulation referred to in paragraphs (d) and (e), in the proper form, the Commission will issue its supplemental order authorizing the exercise of rights conferred by such franchises. Said franchises and stipulation shall be filed on or before August 31, 1929.

In conformity with the above, Pacific Gas and Electric Company has filed certified copy of franchise granted by the County of Santa Clara to San Jose Gas Company, a predecessor company, under date of April 7, 1876, and satisfactory stipulation as to the value of permits, easements and franchises.

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having complied with certain requirements set forth in Decision No. 21311 of this Commission,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise by Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the rights and privileges of franchise granted by the County of Santa Clara in so far as such exercise is necessary to the construction, maintenance and use of the gas transmission system above referred to.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
