BY THE COMMISSION:O P I N I O N

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corpora-
tion (hereafter sometimes referred to as applicant or the Telephone
Company), herein requests authority to establish a telephone ex-
change at Floriston, Nevada County, California, and to make effec-
tive certain rates for exchange and interexchange telephone service
and telegraph service.

A public hearing was held in this Application by Examiner
Handford at San Francisco on September 16, 1929, and the matter then
and there was submitted for decision.

Floriston, a town of approximately 350 people, is entire-
ly dependent upon the operations of the Crown-Zellerbach Paper
Company, which established the settlement about its paper mill.
The only telephone service at Floriston at this time is from a

toll station and a demand has come for intercommunication in the community.

Walter J. Dodge, General Tariff Engineer for the Telephone Company, the only witness at the hearing, placed in evidence Exhibit No. 1 which includes maps of the proposed exchange and base rate areas and rates for exchange and interexchange telephone service and telegraph service. There is no change proposed in the interexchange telephone and telegraph rates.

No objection to the Telephone Company's proposal has been received and it appears that the interests of the public will be conserved by the establishment of a telephone exchange at Floriston.

O R D E R

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company having requested authority from the Railroad Commission to establish a telephone exchange at Floriston, Nevada County, and to file and make effective certain rates for exchange telephone service therein and rates for interexchange telephone service and telegraph service between Floriston Exchange and other toll and telegraph points, a public hearing having been held in the proceeding, and the matter having been submitted for decision,

The Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby finds as a fact that public interest requires the establishment of a telephone exchange at Floriston by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and, basing its order on the foregoing finding of fact and such other findings of fact as are contained in the opinion which precedes this order,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company shall,

(1) Establish and begin to operate within six (6) months from and after the date of this order a telephone exchange at Floriston, Nevada County, with continuous twenty-four (24) hour service in an exchange area and with a base rate area as shown on a map, in the Telephone Company's Exhibit No. 1, filed at the hearing.

(2) Discontinue Floriston toll station as of the date of the establishment of the Floriston Exchange.

(3) Establish rates for local exchange telephone service in Floriston Exchange as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, effective on and after the date of the establishment of said Exchange.

(4) Establish rates for interexchange telephone service and telegraph service between Floriston Exchange and outside points as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and on the basis used generally throughout the State of California, effective on and after the date of the establishment of said Exchange.

(5) Submit to the Railroad Commission, for filing, maps showing the exchange and base rate areas, rates for local exchange telephone service, interexchange telephone service and telegraph service for Floriston Exchange as referred to in (1), (2), (3) and (4) above, and such other rates and rules and regulations as may

be approved, on or before the fifth day immediately preceding the date of the establishment of the Floriston Exchange.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
