A public hearing on the application was conducted by Examiner Satterwhite at Helendale on September 3rd, 1929, at which time the matter was taken under submission. The proposed crossing is located along the East and West center line of Section 6, T 7 N, R 4 W, S. B. B. & M. The Railway Company does not oppose the granting of this crossing provided the present public road crossing located approximately one-half (1/2) mile north therefrom is closed to traffic. There was no opposition to the closing of this crossing which was installed during the early part of 1929 by authority of this Commission, Decision No. 3910, issued in 1916.
