ORDER

Edith D. Moulton having made application to this Commission for authority to sell to A.J. Nourse the unincorporated public utility water system owned and operated under the fictitious name of "Moulton Water Works", which provides domestic water service to a portion of the Town of Ripon, California, and A.J. Nourse, who owns and operates the Ripon Water Company, an unincorporated public utility which supplies the major portion of the Town of Ripon, having joined in this application and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Edith D. Moulton be and she is hereby authorized to sell to A.J. Nourse and said A.J. Nourse be and he is hereby authorized to purchase and acquire the water system and properties known as the Moulton Water Works, at Ripon, California, more particularly described in the application herein and in accordance with the terms and conditions as set out in the copy of the Bill of Sale and inventory attached to the application

and made a part thereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the thirty-first day of December, 1929, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Edith D. Moulton within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Edith D. Moulton actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, she shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such **CONTROL and possession** were relinquished.
3. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
