BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of SAMUEL GERSON, doing business under the fictitious name of Gerson Water Company, for authority to sell public utility property, and T.J. NESTOR to purchase same.

ORDER

Samuel Gerson, doing business under the fictitious name of Gerson Water Company, having made application to the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer his public utility water system which supplies water to the residents of Tracts Nos. 6627 and 7184, Los Angeles County, to T.J. Nestor, who joins in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the authority should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Samuel Gerson, doing business under the fictitious name of Gerson Water Company, be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to T.J. Nestor and said T.J. Nestor be and he is hereby authorized to purchase and acquire that certain public utility water system supplying water to Tracts Nos. 6627 and 7148, Los Angeles County, which system is more particularly described in the application herein, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply

only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the first day of February, 1930, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Samuel Gerson within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Samuel Gerson actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
3. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
