BY THE COMMISSION -

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, by Decision No.21709, granting to applicant herein, (Calistoga and Clear Lake Stage Company) authority to extend its service from Myrtledale Hot Springs and Calistoga to San Francisco, via Black Point cut-off, requires the filing of tariffs by said applicant showing a 10% reduction in rates over the entire system of Calistoga and Clear Lake Stage Company, and

WHEREAS, it now appears that said 10% reduction should apply only to the fares shown in the application herein, now therefore,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition No.3 of the order in Decision No.21709 be amended by eliminating the words "over the entire system", making it read:

That applicant, within thirty (30) days from the date hereof, shall file tariff of rates identical with the tariff of rates attached to the application herein, except that said passenger rates shall be reduced by 10%, in accordance with amendment offered by applicant at hearing held on September 4, 1929.

In all other respects the order is to remain unchanged.
