SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Stockton Electric Railroad Company having requested an extension of time of sixty days in which to commence bus operations authorized by Decision No. 21599, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that condition two of said decision be modified to read as follows:

"2. Applicant shall file, in duplicate, within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date hereof, tariff of rates and time schedules to be satisfactory to the Railroad Commission, and shall commence operation of said service on or before the 25th day of January, 1930."

In all other respects Decision No. 21599 shall remain in full force and effect.
