Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of freight loading platform adjacent to the Team Track and located at Redlands on its Main line in San Bernardino County, and shown in Yellow on a blue-print map (L. A. Divn. Drawing D 143 ) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the freight platform proposed to be abandoned is owned by applicant, and that said platform is no longer required and interferes with the loading of grapes direct from trucks to freight cars; that said platform is not now needed nor, likely to be needed in the future.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to abandon and remove its freight platform serving the Team Track and located at Redlands on its Main line in San Bernardino County and as more definitely shown in Yellow on Map L.A.Divn. Drawing D 143 attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
