## BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the Board of Supervisors of Lassen County for an order that a wig-wag be placed at the crossing of the County Highway and the Fernley & Lassen Branch of Southern Pacific Railroad in town of Litchfield, County of Lassen.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Lassen, State of California, filed the above entitled application with this Commission asking that it issue an order directing that a wigwag signal be installed at the crossing at grade of County Highway over Fernley-Lassen Branch of Southern Pacific Company at Litchfield Station, County of Lassen, State of California. Said crossing has been designated by this Commission as Crossing No. AX-367.2. Subsequent to the filing of this application, it was agreed between the parties that if the approaches to said crossing were improved and that if cars were not left standing within two hundred (200) feet of the crossing, unless necessary for loading and unloading, that a wigwag signal was not necessary. Southern Pacific Company has advised the Commission, by letter, that the heretofore conditions have been complied

with. It, therefore, appears to this Commission that this application should be dismissed;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
