ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR MODIFICATION
 OF ORDER

Bay Cities Transit Company has applied for an order of the Railroad Commission modifying its order in Decision No.21765 granting to Pacific Electric Railway Company an operating right for an automotive passenger stage service between Hollywood and Santa Monica, which right provides that no local service shall be performed by said Pacific Electric Railway Company "between the intersection of Marine and Main Streets, Santa Monica, and the intersection of Federal Avenue and Wilshire Boulevard, City of Los Angeles."

It is the contention of applicant herein that the restriction as to local service should show Sepulveda Avenue as the eastern boundary of the territory in which Pacific Electric was denied the right to perform local service.

We have given careful consideration to the record in the above entitled proceedings and are of the opinion that the order sought to be modified is fully justified by the evidence and that

the application for an order of modification should be denied.
Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application of Bay Cities
Transit Company for a modification of the order heretofore
issued in Decision No.21765 be and the same is hereby denied.
