O P I N I O N

On October 28, 1929, an order was issued on the Commission's own motion instituting an investigation into the matter of the filing by public utilities of certain information relating to dams. A copy of the proposed general order having been submitted to the utilities a public hearing was held on December 3, 1929. A full consideration of the record adduced justifies, in my opinion, the issuance of this general order, amended in accordance with the findings herein. The following form of order is recommended.

O R D E R

An investigation having been instituted on the Commission's own motion as to the filing by public utilities of certain information relating to dams, a public hearing having been held and the

matter now being under submission,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA
HEREBY FINDS AS A FACT that the provisions of the general order
set out below are just and reasonable, and therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following regulation
shall be in force and effect, and shall be known as General Order
No. 50-B:

"General Order No. 50-B

Approved December 7, 1929 - Effective January 7, 1930.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all public utilities
shall file with the Railroad Commission the final plans
and specifications covering any construction, recon-
struction, alteration or repair of dams within thirty
(30) days after their approval by the State Engineer.

This order shall become effective thirty (30)
days from and after the date hereof, at which time
General Orders No. 50 and 50-A shall be revoked and of
no further force and effect.
