In the matter of the Application of FRED A. SUTHERLAND to sell and SAN DIEGO ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY to buy the operative rights of the former to his (1) La Jolla, (2) Encanto-Lemon Grove, and (3) National City-Chula Vista passenger stage lines in the County of San Diego, and the application of San Diego Electric Railway Company for certificates of public convenience and necessity covering said operations and the application of San Diego Electric Railway Company for the consolidation of said operations into its general system on the zone fare basis applicable thereto, including certain changes in fares, schedules and zone lines, the abandonment of certain service and substitution of different character service therefor.
