IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (3) of this Commission's Decision No. 21550, dated September 12th, 1929, in the above entitled proceeding, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

(3) An automatic wig-wag, conforming with Standard No. 3 of General Order No. 75 of this Commission, shall be installed and maintained for the protection of said crossing.

In all other respects this Commission's order heretofore entered in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
