Decision No. 21927.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing it to (a) discontinue non-agency station (b) tear down and remove passenger station building at North Vallejo in the County of Solano, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station and the removal of its passenger station building at North Vallejo on its Napa Branch in Solano County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map marked "Southern Pacific Company, North Vallejo," attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that under authority of this Commission it is not now operating passenger trains on said Napa Branch and that it is not necessary to maintain said passenger station building and said non-agency station at North Vallejo.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station and remove its passenger station building at North Vallejo located on its Napa Branch in Solano County and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
