In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at non-agency station of Buchli in the County of Napa, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the removal of a passenger shelter shed at its non-agency station Buchli, on its Santa Rosa Branch, Napa County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (Southern Pacific Company - Buchli) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that, under authority of this Commission, no passenger business is transacted on its Santa Rosa Branch and that said passenger station is not now or likely to be used in the future and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation,

to remove its passenger shelter shed at its non-agency station of Buchli, located on the Santa Rosa Branch in Napa County and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
