BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the abandonment of non-agency station of Lyda, County of Monterey, State of California, and the abandonment and removal of spur track at said station.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Lyda, in Monterey County, California, and the abandonment and removal of a spur track at said station.

Applicant alleges that no passenger or freight business was transacted at said non-agency station during the annual period ending July, 1929; that said spur track was constructed in 1915 for the handling of shipments of fire wood which was being cut off the adjoining Tarpey Ranch property; that said track has not been used for two (2) years; and that said track is not now required nor, in the opinion of of applicant, likely to be required in the future.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Lyda, Monterey County, California, to abandon and remove a spur track at said station and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
