O P I N I O N

W.F. Kime supplying water to the residents of Tract No. 5775, known as Santa Fe Heights, Los Angeles County, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer his public utility water system to the Kime Realty Company.

A public hearing in this matter was held before Examiner Satterwhite at Los Angeles.

W.F. Kime has formed a corporation known as the Kime Realty Company, controlled entirely by himself and his wife. In view of the fact that all of his other business activities are conducted in the name of the Kime Realty Company, applicant desires to transfer this water system to this company and to operate it in conjunction with another water plant owned by the Kime Realty Company, which was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity by this Commission in its Decision No. 21743, dated November 1, 1929. It appears that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

W.F. Kime having asked permission to transfer his

public utility water system to the Kime Realty Company, a corporation, a public hearing having been held thereon, the matter having been duly submitted and the Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that W.F. Kime be and he is hereby authorized to sell and transfer to the Kime Realty Company, a corporation, his public utility water system and properties supplying water to the territory known as Tract No. 5775, Los Angeles County, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the first day of April, 1930, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by W.F. Kime within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
