O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Wechicka on its Santa Rosa Branch in Sonoma County.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at the non-agency station of Wechicka during the annual period ending August 31, 1929; that the abandonment of said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Wechicka, located on the Santa Rosa Branch of its Western Division in

Sonoma County, and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
