

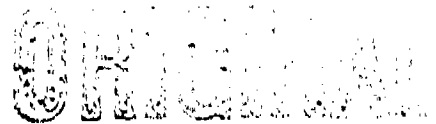
Decision No. 22013.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application
of the Railway Express Agency, Inc.,
for authority to abandon its agency
at Waukena, County of Tulare, State
of California.

O R D E R

Railway Express Agency, Inc., has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency station at Waukena in Tulare County, California.

Applicant alleges that but \$52.42 business was transacted at said station during the six months' period ending December, 1929; that interested shippers and receivers of express have been interviewed by applicant and have expressed their approval to the proposed abandonment; that express shipments moving into or out of said point will be handled provided they are tendered to or received from the express messenger upon trains stopping at said station, and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said agency is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Railway Express Agency, Inc., to abandon its agency at Waukena, in Tulare County, California, and to eliminate said station from its records as an agency station; provided, however, that coincident with the abandonment of said agency applicant will continue to handle express shipments at the car door of trains stopping at said station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
