In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of passenger station building at non-agency station of Edenvale in the County of Santa Clara, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of its passenger station building at Edenvale, in Santa Clara County, State of California, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map ( M W D 6990) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that but eight (8) passengers boarded its trains at said station during the annual period ending July, 1929; that said building is an obstruction to construction of a second main line track in this vicinity; that applicant will continue to handle such passenger business as is offered from said station of Edenvale; and that, in the opinion of applicant the continued maintenance of the station building is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation,

to abandon and remove its passenger station building at Edenvale, in Santa Clara County, provided, however, that coincident with the abandonment of said station building applicant will provide a dirt platform for entraining and detraining passengers at said Edenvale.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
