ORDER OF DISMISSAL AND ORDER PARTIALLY REVOKING PRIOR ORDER

Decision No. 21551 in Cases 2690 ami 2702 was rendered September 12, 1929. On October 10, 1929, the Commission issued an order of suspension and investigation in Case 2770. Application 16056 was filed by Southern Pacific Company on October 30, On December 23, 1929, Attorneys for City of Alemeda and 1929. Southern Pacific Company filed a stipulation "that the above entitled proceedings may be dismissed and that the decision and order heretofore rendered and entered in proceeding No. 2702 may be recated and set aside."

The "above entitled proceedings" referred to are Cases 2702 and 2770 and Application No. 16056. Case 2690 was a complaint filed by the City of Alameda respecting the fare between Alameda and the Alameda Airport.

The Commission having given careful consideration to the stipulation and request above mentioned, and

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision 21551 in Cases 2690 and 2702 be and it is hereby partially set aside and vacated in so far as said decision pertains to Case 2702. In all other respects the said decision shall remain in full force and effect, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Case 2702, Case 2770 and Application 16056 be and they are hereby dismissed.
