In the matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of station building at non-agency station of West Orange in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of the station building located at its non-agency station of West Orange on its Santa Ana Branch, Los Angeles Division, in Los Angeles County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (L.A. Divn. Drawing A-249, Sheet No. 1) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that said station building is an obstruction to the opening of a street as proposed by the City of Santa Ana; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the station building is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove the station building located at its non-agency station of West Orange on the Santa Ana Branch of its Los Angeles Division in Los Angeles County.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
